- A JPEG or PDF image should be delivered to the yearbook room on a USB drive or emailed to <u>k harrison@fortgibsontigers.org</u>.
- The Tiger Yearbook staff does NOT suggest using copied prints of photographs in your artwork unless you are having them professionally scanned at a high dpi. In the past, scans of such prints have produced "checkerboard" distortions of the original. Instead, assemble your artwork digitally (JPEG) and save it as an image file on a USB.
- Consider the orientation of the space where your ad will appear. Full-page and quarter-page ads are taller than they are wide (portrait or vertical orientation), whereas half-page, eighth-page, and sixteenth-page ads are wider than they are tall (landscape or horizontal orientation).
- You may design and submit your own senior ad (or have it professionally designed); otherwise, the yearbook staff will design the ad for you. Please let the staff know at the time of purchase if you plan to submit your own design. The completed ad is due by **November 3, 2023** and should be submitted using one of the methods listed above.

Attention Customers: All Advertisements for the yearbook are sold on a "pending availability" basis; therefore, in order to ensure that your senior ad is included, buy your ad as early as possible! Once the allotted senior ad page space has been sold, no further ads will be accepted.
