Weekly Theme: review of Kindergarten; football/cheerleading; homecoming

This Week:



Reading: I will be testing the next 2 weeks so your child will have a guided reading book **but I won't be going over the book much with them.** Please make sure they read & retell them to you. They should also have a library book. If they have time they may read it too. Please remember to sign your child's reading log in their red homework folder. They should be reading around 10 to 15 minutes a night. If your child forgets their book you can have them practice their word list. Your child will be working in class on phonics, spelling, and writing work stations. We are focusing on CVC (consonant/ vowel/ consonant), beginning and ending consonant digraphs, reading word list A, as well as a review of kindergarten skills during the 1<sup>st</sup> trimester.



Math: We are continuing to work on our first 1<sup>st</sup> grade math topic today. It is addition. We will be working on adding to 12 with manipulatives.



Phonics/Spelling: Phonics & spelling are done in class. This week we are working on new heart words & phoneme blending. We focus on a particular phonics lesson each week & will test over it on Friday but no grade is given for that assessment. It is done for practice. This week we are working on heart words in, is, for, that, & it. We will also work on short and long vowel i phonemes, & digraph sh.



Grammar/Writing: We will continue writing in our journals. We will also complete a sentence writing over our mascot the tiger. We also might finish our family writing.
